

## Video consent form

If you don't want us to use your video in the future, you can tell us at any time (this is called 'withdrawing consent') and we will stop using it in our publicity. But because the film may have been shared online, we can't guarantee that other people won't carry on using it.

## My video is ready - what should I do now?

1. Fill in the form on the back page and post it to us using the FREEPOST address on the bottom of the consent form on page 4. Or fill in the form online [here](#). If you are under 16, your mum or dad will need to fill the form in for you. The form asks you for permission to use your video.

- **Your full name**
- **What your video shows.** For example, you could tell us where you were, what you were doing and who else was in the video
- **Your age**

## What will happen to my video?

The Compass Team will put together as many of the video clips as we can. We probably won't be able to include all of your video unless it's very short and we might not be able to include everyone's video.

## Tips for filming

1. You can video yourself or ask someone else to video you. If you like, you can get the whole family or a group of friends involved!

2. Hold your phone this way to film



4. If you're videoing something happening, get in close and move the phone or tablet as smoothly as you can. Or keep it still to focus on the action.

5. For a different shot, try videoing from above or below. It's fun to try different things!

3. If you are videoing yourself talking or someone else talking, make sure the phone is up close so they can be heard! That means arms length or closer. If there's lots of noise where you are, you need to get even closer.



6. Give the phone or tablet a wipe before you film – a smudge or a greasy mark could spoil your filming!



8. Keep trying! If it goes wrong, try again – professional film makers do this all the time.
